



## Down:

- Insulated and often water-resistant bag designed for people to sleep in comfortably while camping.
- 2. Traditional tools for navigation in the wilderness.
- 3. A package of basic tools and supplies prepared in advance as an aid to survival in an emergency.
- 6. A shelter consisting of sheets of fabric or other material draped over or attached to a frame of poles or ropes.
- 7. A bag that is designed to hold all of the items needed for camping and is carried on one's back.

## Across:

- 4. A marked or unmarked path in the wilderness often used for hiking or backpacking.
- 5. The activity of going for long walks in the countryside or wilderness, often associated with camping.
- 8. A portable battery-operated light.
- 9. An area where an individual or group can pitch one or more tents or park a camper.
- 10. A fire created outdoors, used for warmth, cooking, or simply for ambiance during a camping trip.
