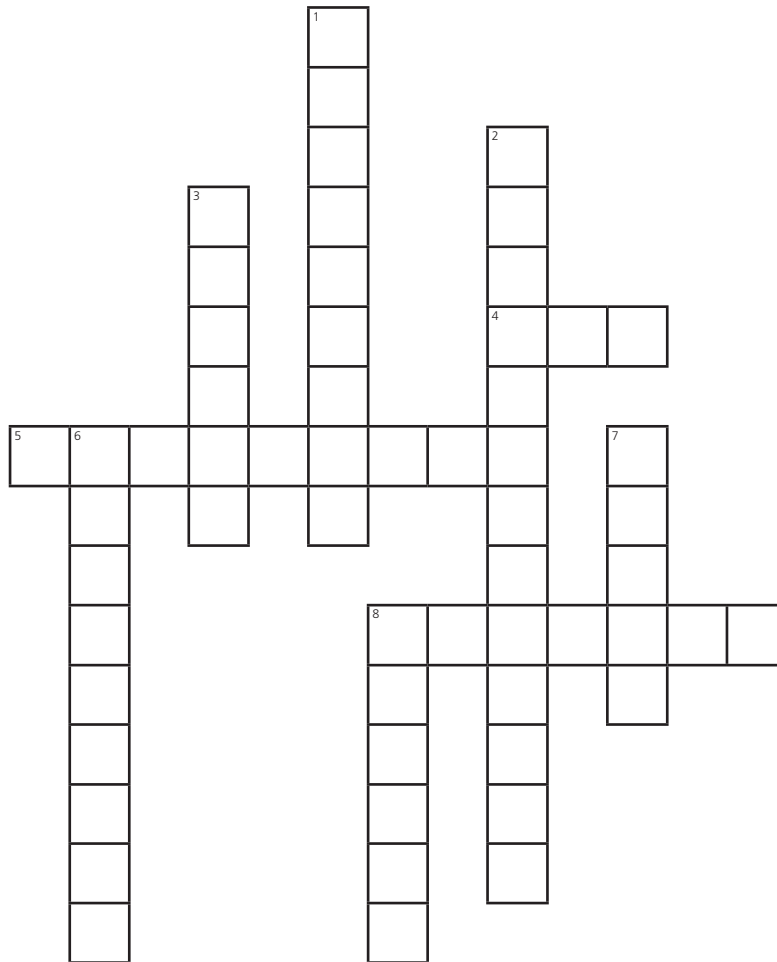

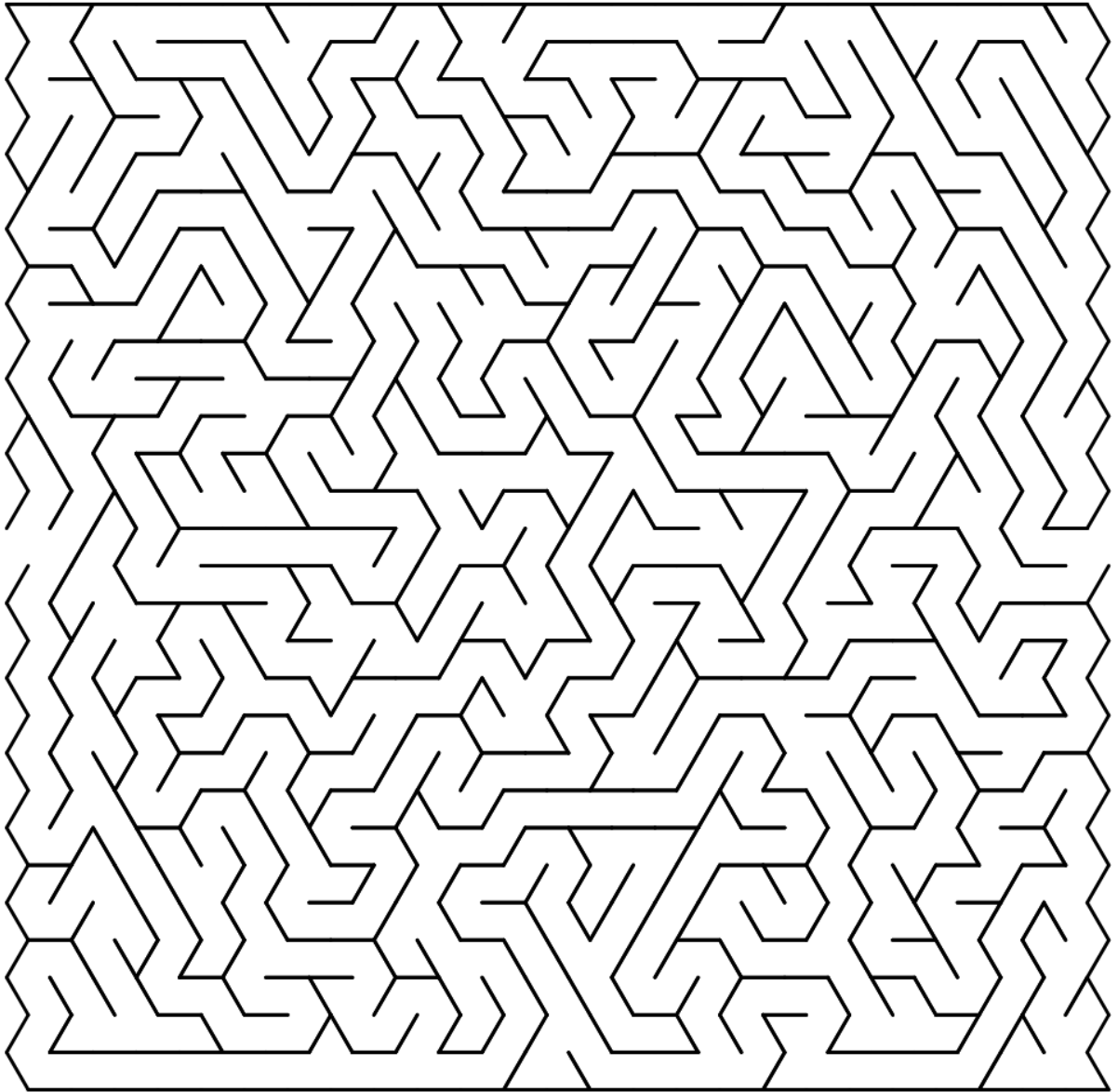
4. The star at the center of our solar system that provides light and heat to the planets.
