POINTS TRACKER GUIDELINES – VIRTUAL

Points can be redeemed online from August 2025 – July 2026.

1. Send in a copy or a picture of your report card to receive points for each "A" or the equivalent highest mark.
2. Log into video banking once a month. A transaction into a youth savings account is not required.
3. Did you receive birthday money? Make a deposit during your birthday month into your youth savings account.
4. Send in a picture of a coupon from a community event to receive points.
5. Send in proof (a picture, signature, or form), of participating in volunteer or missions trip work for an hour or more. These points can be claimed once a month.
6. Send in a completed Everence educational sheet. Sheets are available online at everence.com/youth-rewards.
7. Make a deposit of \$25 or more into your youth savings account (proof of deposit required). Earn 30 points for your \$25 first deposit and 10 points for each of the next four \$25 deposits.
8. Send in proof (a picture or a screenshot) of your Greenlight app.
9. Refer a friend to EFCU and earn points for every friend who opens an account. The friend must state that they were referred and give your name when opening their account. They will be emailed a referral card to send back to you. Send in the filled-out card to redeem points.
10. Open a youth savings account with EFCU. For new members only.
11. EFCU products and services include things like opening a checking account, applying for a debit card, opening a jubilee savings account, or signing up for online banking.
12. Fill out the youth survey at the end of the program.

Total points allowed in each category correspond to the number of circles. Child must send required proof to Everence Federal Credit Union between August 2025 and July 2026 to receive points. Points cannot be shared or transferred to other Youth Rewards Program participants.

Consent by an adult is required for youth under 18. Adult supervision and assistance may be required to complete activities.
